
Installing Bradford Network Access Control on a Windows PC

Welcome to the Furman campus! This application will setup the required software for you to gain network access in non-residential areas while on campus as a student. **NOTE:** You must have **ALL** of your Windows updates installed before attempting to run this application. Failure to do so could result in faulty installation and configuration. **All non-Furman anti-viruses must be uninstalled as well, before beginning this process**.

- I. Once you have arrived on campus, connect to the FU-STUDENTS wifi network. You may have to enter your network credentials and accept the certificate if this is your first time connecting. You will not be able to complete the next steps if this action is not taken.
- 2. Once connected, open a browser to http://bradford.fu.campus/registration and click the link to register a PC.



3. Fill out the form completely, using your NetID as your username. Click Download.




4. Find the software, and right-click to Run as Administrator.



7. After the software has installed, a box will pop up for your NetID and password. Enter these, and click OK.


